

Yazoo Library Association Membership Form

The Yazoo Library Association was organized in 1838 and incorporated by the Mississippi Legislature in 1840. It has been providing public library service to the citizens of Yazoo County for over 160 years. The YLA is a citizens' organization and anyone can join, but it is not necessary to join to use our library.

The cost to be a member of the YLA is \$15.00 per year for an individual membership and \$20.00 per year for a family membership.

Membership fees support the Ricks Memorial Library, and have helped pay for items such as new computers, books and reading programs.

Association benefits include:

- Extended borrowing privileges: 10 books, 5 books on CD, 20 honor system books, 5 magazines and/or 5 DVD's
- Extended loan period for books (21 days instead of 14)
- Waiver of the \$2.00 fee to replace lost library cards
- Voting privileges at the Yazoo Library Association Annual Meeting
