Mr. Horace Noble, founder the Chicago American Pilot Association says, "he can see a successful show stage in Yazoo City after having planned four in and around the Chicago Area. Mr. Noble is presently Regional Director of the Chicago Airman Association, board member of Airman International, and treasurer of the Black Automobile Association.

Mr. Noble was born January 17, 1933 just west of Yazoo City. He attended school at St. Francis, Yazoo City, Mississippi. After leaving Yazoo City in 1946, he spent 2 years in the Marines with combat in Korea. He attended Wilson Junior College, of Chicago and North Western University. Special courses were taken at Michigan State.

Fourteen years of Mr. Noble's work experience have been in law enforcement. He was promoted to the highest position, being Commander of one-half of the Sheriff's Policeman of Cook County, State of Illinois. Mr. Noble went into Automobile Dealership in 1967 and is the present owner of the Lincoln-Mercury Dealer, southside Chicago.

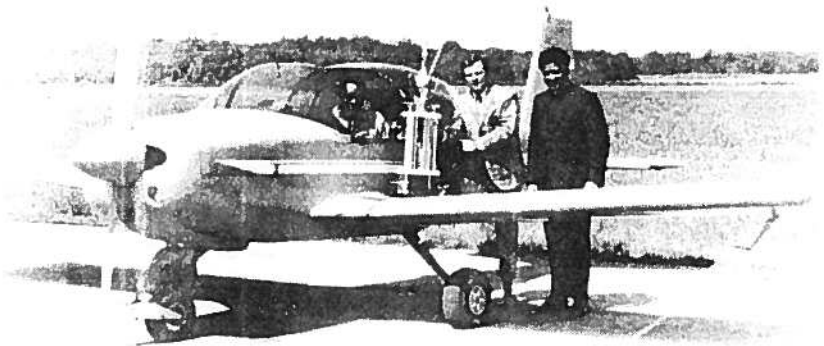
